

Black Coral Elephant Ear

Colocasia esculenta Royal Hawaiian[®] - Black Coral - PPAF

- Black glossy foliage with blue veins
- Tropical looking plant adds interest to any garden
-
- Soil should be kept moist
- H: 36" W: 36"
- Perennial



White Lava Elephant Ears

Colocasia esculenta 'White Lava'

- H: 3 feet W: 2-3 feet
- Clumping elephant ear with large glossy green leaves. As season progresses, a wide band of creamy white grows down the center of each leaf.
- Zones 7b-10b



Coffee Cups Elephant Ear

Colocasia esculenta 'Coffee Cups'

- H: up to 5 feet W: 36”
- Glossy green leaves with dark purple-black stem.
- Dramatic leaf cupping
- Zones 8a-10b
- Best in freshly ground soil.



Alocasia 'Mayan Mask'

Alocasia 'Mayan Mask'

- H: 72-96 inches W: 36-48"W
- Upright elephant ear with white veins and maroon undersides.
- Creates a tropical feel
- Zones 3-10



Walkers Low Catmint

Nepeta X faassenii – Walkers Low

- H: 24-30 inches W:36 inches
- 2007 Perennial of the year
- Attractive fragrant gray-green foliage
- Bluish-purple flowers from spring to fall
- Drought resistant when established



Bougainvillea Vine

- H: 8-20' W: 5-6'
- Thorny ornamental evergreen climber
- Flower-like bracts near its flowers
- Some leaves are variegated
- Blooms summer
- Relatively maintenance free
- Good in coastal conditions
- Frost sensitive, winter inside
- Good in hanging basket



Peony 'Sarah Bernhardt'

Paeonia lactiflora 'Sarah Bernhardt'

- H: up to 34" W: 24"
- Perennial
- Best in rich fertile soil
- Large, showy bowl shaped rose pink fragrant blooms in Spring.
- Rich dark green foliage until frost.



Society Garlic

Tulbaghia violacea

- Perennial
- Grass-like leaves 1' tall.
- Pale light purple/pink flowers blooms all year
- Water frequently during growing season
- Drought tolerant
- Light, sandy soil



Verbena Homestead Purple

Verbena canadensis 'Homestead Purple'

- Showy, intense purple flowers
- Grows in wet or dry soils
- Heat and drought tolerant
- Water frequently until well established
- Trailing habit



Lenten Rose 'Confetti Cake'

Heleborous 'Confetti Cake-Wedding Party Series'

- H: 18-24" W: 18-24"
- Perennial
- Blooms late Winter to early Spring.
- 'Confetti Cake's grab your attention with 2.5-3" double, white flowers, petals burgundy-speckled towards the center.
- Perfect for moist woodland areas.



Lenten Rose 'Flower Girl'

Heleborous 'Flower Girl-Wedding Party Series'

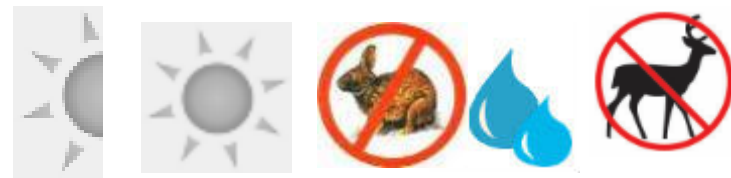
- H: 18-24" W: 18-24"
- Perennial
- Blooms late Winter to early Spring.
- 'Flower Girl' has 2.5 to 3" blush to light-pink double flowers
- Perfect for moist woodland areas.



Lenten Rose 'Rome in Red'

Heleborous 'Rome in Red Honeymoon Series'

- H: 18-24" W: 18-24"
- Perennial
- Blooms late Winter to early Spring
- The 3–4" blossoms range in color from rich maroon to deep burgundy. Golden centers with creamy white stamens add the perfect touch
- Perfect for moist woodland areas



Wild Blue Indigo

Baptisia Australis

- H: 3-4 feet
- Well drained soil
- Perennial
- Spring bloomer
- Host plant for several species butterfly larvae



False Indigo 'Lemon Meringue'

Baptisia Decadence

- Perennial
- H: 2-3' W: 2-3'
- Bright yellow flower in late spring appear above mounds of clover like blue green foliage
- Decorative seed pods in Autumn
- Drought tolerant



Foam Flower 'Brandywine'

Tiarella cordifolia 'Brandywine'

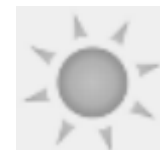
- Perennial
- H: 10-12”
- Moist well drained soil
- Green leaves with dark center, bronze fall color
- Blooms mid spring to early summer
- Great groundcover; fills in by runners



Foam Flower 'Running Tapestry'

Tiarella cordifolia 'Running Tapestry'

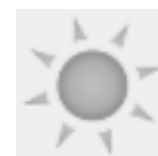
- Perennial
- H: 12-15”
- Moist well drained soil
- Green heart shaped leaves with dark red center
- Blooms mid spring to early summer
- Great groundcover; fills in by runners



Foam Flower 'Oakleaf'

Tiarella x Sugar and Spice

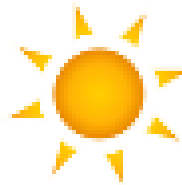
- Perennial
- H: 10-12"
- Moist well drained soil
- Oakleaf shaped leaves with light pink flowers Brilliant burgundy winter color
- Blooms mid spring to early summer
- Great groundcover



Gay Feather 'Blazing Star'

Liatris spicata

- H: 3 feet W: 3 feet
- Perennial
- Well drained soil to wet soil
- Spikes of violet flowers rising above the foliage from mid summer to early fall
- Grassy leaves remain green in color throughout the season



Cardinal Flower 'Queen Victoria'

Lobelia Cardinalis 'Queen Victoria'

- H: 3-4 feet W: 2-3 feet
- Blooms in summer
- Moist soil
- Medium water
- Perennial with cardinal red flower and bronze foliage
- Good for rain gardens



Cardinal Flower 'Black Truffle'

Lobelia Cardinalis 'Black Truffle'

- H: 3-4 feet W: 2-3 feet
- Perennial
- Native Cardinal Flower with deep, dark foliage and bright red flowers.
- Nearly black foliage and bushy, upright habit. Butterfly magnet. Good for rain gardens
- Blooms: Late spring - summer
- Water: Moist – Medium



Foxglove 'Dalmation Peach'

Digitalis purpurea

- Herbaceous perennial
- H:2-4 feet W: 12-18 inches
- Clear, peach colored blooms late spring through summer
- Regular watering - weekly or more in extreme heat
- Growth: fast
- Low, mounded foliage is neat and compact
- Great for middle or back of the border



Foxglove 'Dalmation Purple'

Digitalis purpurea

- Herbaceous perennial
- H: 2-4 feet W: 12-18 inches
- Deep rose-purple bells late spring through summer
- Needs regular watering - weekly or more in extreme heat
- Growth: fast



Autumn Fern 'Brilliance'

Dryopteris erythrosora 'Brilliance'

- Dwarf-growing herbaceous fern
- H: 1.5-2.5 ' W: 1.5-2.5
- Disease resistant
- Plant in shade sheltered from wind
- Water regularly to maintain moist soil
- Easy care



Coneflower “White Swan”

Echinacea purpurea ‘White Swan’

- Herbaceous flowering plant in the daisy family
- H: 40 in. W:18 in
- Plant together in good big clumps
- Big bright white flowers June - Sept.
- Good in full sun or partial shade
- Drought tolerant
- Flower head turns black as the seeds mature, adding further interest and providing nourishment for goldfinches.



Gaura 'Little Janie'

Gaura Lindheimeri 'Little Janie'

- Perennial border flower
- H: 16-18 inches Space: 16- 8 inches apart
- Blooms early summer to early fall
- Bicolor white with pink edges
- Thrives in high heat and humidity
- Dwarf Habit puts in front of border



Blanket Flower

Gaillardia sunrita 'Burgandy Picotee'

- Perennial
- H: 14-18 inches W: 14-18 inches
- Thrives in poor sandy soils
- Blooms all summer into fall
- High drought tolerance
- Full to part sun
- Attracts birds, butterflies, bees



Blanket Flower

Gaillardia grandiflora 'Arizona Red'

- Perennial
- H: 12 inches W: 15 inches
- Thrives in poor sandy soils
- Blooms all summer into fall
- High drought tolerance
- Full to part sun
- Attracts birds, butterflies, bees
