**Candy Store 'Coral Crème Drop Garden Phlox** Phlox paniculate 'Ditomdre'

- Herbaceous deciduous perennial
- H: 20-28 in W: 20-28 in
- Easy care disease and pest resistant
- Fast growing
- Blooms: Fragrant rosy coral with deep-pink accents early summer - fall















# Phlox 'Cherry Red' Phlox paniculata 'Peacock Cherry Red'

- Herbaceous perennial
- H:18 24 in W: 18 24 in
- Easy care disease & pest resistance
- Fast growing
- Average water needs but don't overwater
- Blooms: Magenta blooms midsummer – fall
- Fragrant
- Heat tolerant; disease resistant
- Salt tolerant















# Phlox 'Peacock White' Phlox paniculata 'Peacock White'

- Herbaceous perennial
- •H: 18 24 in W: 18 24 in
- Disease & pest resistant
- Fast growing
- Average water needs but don't overwater
- Fragrant white blooms mid-summer - fall













### Coral Autumn Sage Salvia greggii Coral

- Dwarf semi-woody perennial (mint family)
- •H: 3-4 feet W: 3-4 feet
- Well suited for dry areas
- Grows best in full sun
- Well-drained soil. Will not tolerate wet feet

















### Mexican Sage Salvia leucantha

- H: 2-4 feet W: 2-4 feet
- Perennial
- Blooms late summer to frost.
- Soft grayish foliage.
- Thrives in heat
- Well drained soils.











#### 'Little Kiss' Salvia Salvia microphylla 'Little Kiss'

- Compact semi-woody deciduous perennial (mint family-sage)
- •H: 18 inches W: 18 inches
- Prune in spring
- Well suited for dry areas
- ·Blooms: red and white bicolor spring - frost. Reblooms
- Grows best in full sun
- Well-drained soil











### Salvia x Free Speech Salvia microphylla 'Free Speech'

- Compact semi-woody deciduous perennial (mint family-sage)
- •H: 2-3 feet W: 2 feet
- Prune in spring
- Well suited for dry areas
- •Blooms: fragrant red from spring frost. Reblooms
- Grows best in full sun
- •Well-drained soil. drought tolerant











#### **Black & Blue Salvia**

#### Salvia guaranitica 'Black and Blue'

- 4'H 3'W
- Perennial
- Tall, dark green stems with bright sage green leaves.
- Bloom Spring to Fall.
- Deadhead spent flowers to encourage additional bloom.
- Two-lipped, tubular, deep blue flowers





#### Dwarf Banana Plant Musa Poquito

- Deciduous perennial
- •H: 3 feet W: 3 feet (Good in containers)
- Heat tolerant
- Flowers: fall
- Well-drained soil
- Water medium













#### Bee Balm 'Grand Palace' Monarda didyma Grand Palace

- Perennial compact shrub
- H: 13-16 in W:16 20 in
- Lavender-purple flowers midlate summer
- Aromatic foliage
- Good mildew resistance

















### Grace Ward Lithodoro Lithodora diffusa 'Grace Ward'

- Perennial evergreen ground cover
- H: 6-12 inches W: 3-4 feet
- Needs regular watering weekly or more in extreme heat
- Beautiful deep blue flowers. Performs best with some shade in extremely hot areas









### Leopard Plant Ligularia dentata 'Othello'

- Herbaceous perennial
- •H: 2-3 feet W: 1.5 2.5 feet
- Yellow-orange blooms July - August
- Maintenance: medium.
   Suggested use: rain garden
- Tolerates heavy shade, wet soil
- Slugs can be troublesome
- Easy care











#### **Shasta Daisy Becky** Leucanthemum x superb 'Becky'

- Herbaceous perennial
- •H: 3-4 feet W: 2-3 feet
- Drought and dry soil tolerant
- Low maintenance
- Deadhead flowers
- Grow in average dry -medium well-drained soil in full sun.
- Wet soils in winter can be fatal.















# Shasta Daisy 'Banana Cream' Leucanthemum superbum 'Banana Cream'

- Perennial
- H: 1-1.5 feet W: 1-2 feet
- Average to medium, welldrained soil
- Lemon yellow semi-double rays with golden orange center; good for cutting.
- Blooms from late spring throughout summer
- Sun to light shade
- Attracts butterflies











### Spanish Lavendar Lavandula stoechas

- Herbaceous evergreen perennial
- H: 30 inches W: 24 inches
- Growth: moderate
- Blooms: fragrant purple flowers spring – fall
- Gray-green foliage
- Good for hot dry regions.
- Water to establish then can be reduced.
- Prune: fall













#### Lantana Lantana camara

- Broadleaf evergreen upright shrub
- •H: 3-4 feet W:1-3 feet
- Moderate grower
- Bright orange blooms July - frost
- •Full sun. Low maintenance
- Drought tolerant















# Spotted Dead Nettle Lamium maculatum 'White Nancy'

- Herbaceous perennial ground cover
- •H:12 inches
- •Width: 18 inches
- Fast growing
- Shade loving. Needs wet or constantly moist soil
- White flowers spring summer
- Can be invasive in northern states













#### Siberian Iris 'Caesar's Brother' Iris sibiraca 'Caesar's Brother'

- Herbaceous perennial
- •H: 3-4 feet W: 2.5 3 feet
- Bloom time: May, showy deep purple
- Maintenance: low generally pest-free
- •Plant in in moist well drained soil
- Full sun to part shade
- Water: Medium to wet
- Suggested use: rain garden















#### Variegated Japanese Iris Iris ensata 'Variegata'

- Herbaceous perennial
- Japanese water iris
- •H: 24 36 inches
- Spring blooms: large bright royal purple flowers with small yellow signal
- Easy care
- Growth: moderate
- Grows well in water gardens or in low, soggy ground. Good for backyard ponds or larger container water gardens













#### Yarrow - Deep Rose

#### Achillea millefolium 'Desert Eve (TM) Deep Rose'

- Perennial growing in nearly any sunny condition
- •14-18 inches tall and wide
- Tolerates poor soil
- Low mounds of fragrant ferny foliage
- Dark deep rose flowers
- Heat tolerant
- Growth rate: fast
- Good for cutting, fresh or dried













#### Yarrow - Yellow Achillea milleflorium Sunny Seduction

- Herbaceous perennial
- H:1.5 2.5 feet W:1-2 feet
- Blooms: June September
- Low maintenance, tolerates poor soil
- Fragrant













# Cast Iron Plant Aspidistra elatior

- H: 12-20 inches; W: 2 feet
- Slow growing
- Prefers rich fertile soil but will tolerate range of soil.
- Does not tolerate full sun-Excellent for deep shade.
- Follow regular watering schedule. Watering reduced after establishment.







# Tickseed UpTick™ Cream & Red Coreopsis UpTick™ Cream & Red

- Perennial
- H: 12-14 inches W: 12-14 inches
- Blooms late spring, summer, late summer
- Medium water
- Full sun
- Large cream colored flowers with a burgundy-red eye. The bright flowers cover the tidy mound all summer.











# Tickseed 'Mercury Rising' Coreopsis x 'Mercury Rising'

- To 1.5'H; 2 to 3' W
- Perennial
- Average to sandy /rocky soil, but well drained
- Blooms from June to Sept. with deep red showy flowers
- Some deadheading to encourage additional bloom
- Tolerates drought
- Along borders divide 2-3 years to maintain robustness













#### Japanese Holly Fern Cyrtomium falcatum

- Soil: Well-drained, moist
- Large evergreen fern with glossy, dark green foliage
- Tough plant
- Moderately drought tolerant once established
