# Pineapple Guava

## *Feijoa sellowiana*

- H: 12-15 feet W: 12-15 feet
- Broadleaf evergreen shrub grows best in well drained soil
- Fruit and flowers are edible
- Showy flowers in the spring
- Guava-like fruit ripens in late fall



## Rose Peach Drift *Rosa Peach Drift 'Meiggile'*

- H: 12-24" W: 2 feet
- Floriferous dwarf shrubs
- Soft peach blooms cover the plant from mid-spring to the first hard freeze of late Fall
- Strong disease resistance
- It's low, spreading habit makes it perfect for small gardens and combination planters



# Rose Red Drift

## *Rosa Red Drift 'Meigalpio'*

- H: 12-24 inches W: 2 feet
- Floriferous dwarf shrubs
- Red petite cluster cover the plant from spring to summer
- Strong disease resistance
- It's low, spreading habit makes it perfect for small gardens and combination planters



# Yellow Climbing Rose

## *Rosa Radsun Carefree Sunshine*

- Semi-evergreen climbing rose
- H: 15 - 20 feet long
- Growth: fast
- Brilliant yellow flowers in spring through summer won't fade. Medium green foliage.
- Plant in average, moist well-drained soil. Deep watering at first.
- Needs full sun



# Lady Banks Rose

## *Rosa banksiae* 'Lutea'

- A vigorous climber with rich-green foliage on thornless slender branches.
- Miniature, double yellow or white blooms have a slight fragrance.
- Heavy and prolific spring display. Evergreen in milder climates. Needs regular watering
- Fast-growing, vining habit to 15 to 20 ft. long.
- Seacoast exposure
- Blooms Spring or Early Summer





# Dwarf Sabal Palm

## *Sabal Minor*

- H: 5-8 feet W: 3-6 feet
- Also called: Swamp Palmetto, Dwarf Palmetto
- Drought tolerant; slow growth
- Moist well drained soil
- Evergreen



# Japanese Snowball 'Popcorn'

*Viburnum plicatum* var. *tomentosum* 'Popcorn'

- H: 8-15 feet W: 10-18 feet
- Deciduous shrub blooms late Spring
- 3" Rounded blooms stand out against olive-green foliage
- In Autumn, leathery leaves turn rich shades of red, maroon, and purple



**Hydrangea 'Let's Dance Rhythmic Blue'**  
*Hydrangea macrophylla 'Let's Dance Rhythmic Blue'*

- Deciduous shrub, re-blooming Hydrangea
- H: 24-36 inches Spacing: 24-36 inches
- Part to full sun
- Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Needs regular watering weekly
- Blooms on new and old wood: mid-summer, early-fall. May be trimmed after early summer flowering. Add aluminum sulfate to soil to encourage blue flower color



# Hydrangea 'Twist-n-Shout'

*Hydrangea mac. Endless Summer Twist-n-Shout*

- H: 3.5 feet W: 3.5 feet
- Well drained soil
- A re-blooming lacecap with sturdy red stems-- a cross between Penny Mac and Lady In Red
- Blooms pink or blue depending on soil pH late spring through fall
- Blooms on old wood



# Hydrangea 'Bobo'

## *Hydrangea paniculata* 'Bobo'

- H: 3 feet W: 3 feet
- Dwarf compact deciduous shrub
- Large upright white flowers in late summer
- Blooms turn pink to burgundy in fall



# Hydrangea Oakleaf 'Gatsby Star'

*Hydrangea quercifolia* 'Doughill'

- H: 5-6 feet W: 5-6 feet
- Deciduous shrub
- Double white star shaped blossoms, initially white but age to wine-red
- Foliage turns deep burgundy in fall
- Coastal tolerant



# Hydrangea 'Cardinal Red'

## *Hydrangea macrophylla* 'Cardinal'

- Deciduous French mophead shrub
- H: 4 feet Spacing: 4 feet
- Prefers shade in moist soil
- Blooms on new and old wood: mid-summer, early-fall. May be trimmed after early summer flowering
- Produces dark, cardinal-red flowers with serrated edges on each petal.
- Develops excellent purple foliage color in the fall.



# Hydrangea 'Double Delights'™ Wedding Gown

## *Hydrangea macrophylla Wedding Gown*

- Deciduous shrub; Lacecap Hydrangea
- H: 3-4 feet Spacing: 3-4 feet
- Can tolerate full sun but prefers partial shade in a protected area
- Needs regular watering weekly
- White flowers grow on old wood so prune in August not spring
- Repeat bloomer





# Holly Dwarf Yaupon Bordeaux

## *Ilex vomitoria* Bordeaux-Condeaux

- H: 3-4' W: 4-6' W
- Well drained soil
- Drought and humidity tolerant
- Insect or disease problem free
- Salt tolerant
- Dense multi-stemmed evergreen shrub with a mounded form



# Weeping Yaupon Holly

## *Ilex Vomitoria Pendula*

- 10-20' H 8-12' W
- Native plant that attracts birds and butterflies
- Drought tolerant
- Red berries. Small evergreen shiny leaves usually multi-trunked.
- Yaupon attracts birds and is larval plant for Henry's elfin butterfly
- Good screen plant; salt tolerant and transplants easily. Attractive drooping branch structure.



# Fringe Flower Chinese 'Ruby'

*Loropetalum chinense 'rubrum'*

- H: 4-6 feet W: 4-6 feet
- Broadleaf evergreen with rounded growth habit and reddish purple leaf color
- Dark pink flowers in early spring
- Moist well-drained slightly acidic soil



# Loropetalum Emerald Snow®

## *Loropetalum chinense 'Shang-White'*

- H: 3-4 feet W: 3-4 feet
- Fringe flower
- Evergreen
- Emerges in the spring with bright lime-green foliage, turning to green during summer
- Compact shrub has showy white spider flowers in spring and may repeat in fall
- Needs regular watering, especially in midsummer heat.



# Dwarf Chinese Fringe Flower

## *Loropetalum chinense daruma*

- H: 3-4 feet W: 3-4 feet
- Evergreen produces red tinted foliage that turns to green as it ages
- Blooms that are a hot pink / fuchsia color
- Well drained soil
- Pruning minimal



## Distylium 'Coppertone'

### *Distylium*

- Evergreen shrub
- H: 3-4 feet W: 4-5 feet
- Compact grower
- Disease and insect resistant
- Can also grow in wet soils
- A spreading-mounded shrub with copper-bronze-red emerging foliage that matures to matte blue-green.



# Distylium 'Spring Frost'

## *Distylium*

- Evergreen shrub
- H: 3-4 feet W: 4-5 feet
- New foliage is frosty white colored eventually maturing to medium green
- Disease and insect resistant
- Tolerates heat, drought, and can also grow in wet soils
- Spring Frost is laden with small reddish colored tassel like blooms / flowers in late winter....occasionally persisting into early spring.
- Good for cut flowers



# Distylium 'Blue Cascade'

## *Distylium*

- Evergreen shrub - compact
- H: 3-4 feet W: 4-5 feet
- Matte blue green foliage with cascading, layered habit. Reddish-maroon flowers January - March
- Disease and insect resistant
- Can also grow in wet soils





# Deutzia

## *Gracilis Yuki Cherry Blossom*

- H: 12-24" W: 12-24"
- Miniature deciduous shrubs
- Blooms pink bell-like flowers in spring
- Attractive burgundy fall color
- Resilient and requires little or no maintenance



# Bottlebrush 'Mount Airy'

## *Fothergilla major* 'Mount Airy'

- H: 3-5' W: 3-5'
- Deciduous
- Abundant fragrant white bottlebrush like flowers
- Dark green foliage turns a brilliant yellow-orange-red in fall
- Full to part sun. Moist but well drained soil



# Gardenia 'Jubilation'

## *Gardenia jasminoides 'Leeone'*

- Evergreen flowering shrub
- H: 3-4 feet W: 2-3 feet
- Fragrant heavy bloom in spring - white waxy petals. Re-blooms throughout summer. Good cut flowers
- Full sun to partial shade
- Growth: fast
- Well-drained acidic soil. Low water needs



# 'Crown Jewel' Gardenia

## *Gardenia 'Crown Jewel'*

- Evergreen flowering shrub
- H: 2-3 feet W: 3- 5 feet
- Double fragrant blooms in spring - fall. Good cut flowers
- Full sun to partial shade
- Growth: fast
- Low growing and spreading
- Well-drained acidic soil. Water regularly
- Easy care



# Althea 'Blueberry Smoothie'

## *Hibiscus syriacus (Rose of Sharon)*

- Deciduous tree
- H: 6-8 feet Spread: 5-6 feet
- Blooms: Double bluish-purple Aug - Sept - heaviest flowering occurs in full sun
- Requires moist, well-drained soil
- Growth: moderate
- The Blueberry Smoothie is a magnet for butterflies and hummingbirds



# Rose of Sharon Althea 'Raspberry Smoothie'

## *Hibiscus syriacus* 'Raspberry Smoothie'

- Deciduous tree
- Height: 6-8 feet
- Spread: 5 - 6 feet
- Blooms: Double raspberry -  
Aug - Sept - heaviest  
flowering occurs in full sun
- Requires moist, well-drained  
soil
- Growth: moderate



# Dogwood 'Cherokee'

## *Cornus florida* 'Cherokee'

- H: 15-20 feet W: 20-25 feet
- Deciduous low branched tree
- New leaves emerge bronze-red in spring, maturing to green. Autumn brings fantastic burgundy-red foliage.
- Winter red fruit clinging to bare branches.
- Needs regular watering weekly or more often in extreme heat. Good mildew resistance.
